Salmon play a critical role in fostering a healthy ecosystem. Scientists have proven that salmon bearing streams support significantly larger and healthier forests.



Coho populations state wide are at critically low levels and we have the largest remaining run in OUR Lagunitas Watershed! We have a responsibility to protect this genetic stock, or all we will have left for Creating a streamside buffer is a simple, science-based, strategy to increase protections for this keystone species. Don't allow a few property owners to decide the fate of Marin's forests and streams!
