- Ending Radical And Wasteful Government DEI Programs And Preferencing

## Environmental Impacts

- Prioritization of the expansion of fossil fuel/LNG projects by expediting the permitting process, terminating the Green New Deal, and pausing offshore wind permitting and development
- Rollbacks of environmental protections, including reinstating environmentally damaging decisions and policies for drilling in the Arctic and offshore
- Declaring an Energy Emergency and allowing fossil fuel projects to bypass environmental protections, including the Clean Water Act, Endangered Species Act, and Marine Mammal Protection Act
- Actions outlined in the Executive Orders can disrupt ecosystems, endanger species, and cause long-term environmental harm

## Environmental Justice Impacts

- Disregarding cultural significance, erasing voices, and continuing the exclusion of Indigenous representation in decisions about public lands
- Expediting and expanding fossil fuel projects that impact marginalized communities (low-income, Indigenous, and communities of color), including land displacement, pollution exposure, and loss of livelihood
- Elimination of DEI programs
- Revocation of environmental protections, including those for Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and the National Petroleum Reserve to increase development, directly threatening vulnerable wildlife and Indigenous communities

## Climate Change Impacts

- Withdrawal from the Paris Climate Agreement
- Termination of the Green New Deal
- Revocation of the following, but not limited to:
  - Executive Order 14008 of January 27, 2021 (Tackling the Climate Crisis at Home and Abroad)
  - Executive Order 13990 of January 20, 2021 (Protecting Public Health and the Environment and Restoring Science To Tackle the Climate Crisis)
  - Executive Order 14030 of May 20, 2021 (Climate-Related Financial Risk)
  - Executive Order 14037 of August 5, 2021 (Strengthening American Leadership in Clean Cars and Trucks)
  - Executive Order 14082 of September 12, 2022 (Implementation of the Energy and Infrastructure Provisions of the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022)
  - The Presidential Memorandum of March 13, 2023 (Withdrawal of Certain Areas off the United States Arctic Coast of the Outer Continental Shelf from Oil or Gas Leasing)
  - The Presidential Memorandum of January 6, 2025 (Withdrawal of Certain Areas of the United States Outer Continental Shelf from Oil or Natural Gas Leasing)
